The urgency in his tone makes it a call to action for all believers, both of his day and ours. This passage is one of my personal favorites! This portrayal of a soldier has taught me practical ways of guarding my faith and resisting the enemy. I'm more able to meet daily challenges while keeping my peace. The "Armor of God" passage is in Ephesians 6:10-20. Paul first compels his readers to stand firm for God, with His strength, not our own. Paul explains that our struggle is less a physical one than a spiritual one against our true enemy, the devil. I am sure you will enjoy studying these passages with us as Zander presents his lesson series.

So, today is the day to invite your friends! My challenge is that each person coming invites at least one friend from school, sports practices, or maybe a family member. Just make the invite! The cost this year will be \$30, and be sure to sign up in the foyer so we know you are coming!
