Have you noticed how so much of the campaign rhetoric and advertisements use fear as the way to motivate you to vote for one person or another? They present their opponents as being the worst possible person to serve in our government, even suggesting that our democracy will be in jeopardy if we elect that particular candidate.

We are about a month away from what some politicians are calling the most important election in history! The trouble is, they tend to say that every four years. Again, they are seeking to make the voters afraid of what might happen if the wrong person or party comes to power.

Like you, I have no way of knowing if any of these claims will turn out to be true or not. In the history of our country, our form of government has withstood some great challenges. Don't forget that one time when several states decided to secede from the Union! But whether or not this country suffers serious harm due to the results of the election is really beside the point. Why? Because, as followers of Christ, we are citizens of another kingdom.

The Kingdom of God and the Kingdom of Heaven are mentioned more than 80 times in the New Testament! Jesus began his ministry declaring that the Kingdom of God was at hand. Christ is the king who rules this kingdom, and we, as His followers, have been brought into this kingdom. Consider Colossians 1:13 (ESV):

He [Jesus Christ] has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son.

Presidents and senators will come and go. This earthly kingdom we call the United States may pass away someday. But the heavenly kingdom will never pass away.

But what do I do with these feelings of fear? Consider what Jesus said in Matthew 10:28 (ESV):

And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell.

Put your trust in Christ, and He will keep you in His kingdom.

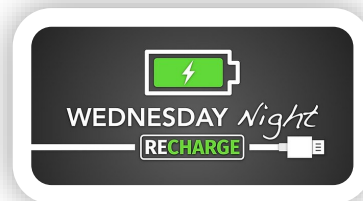
