Let's look at how we "define time" in our future. As Christians, let's add the word "eternity" to that definition.

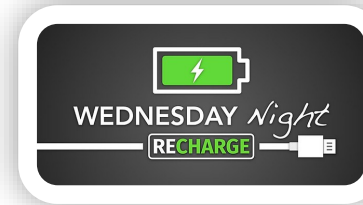
